



## Township of Southgate Council Meeting Highlights November 3, 2021

- The CAO reported on the Eco Park Phase II Land Development and a proposal for Flato Green Inc to purchase 90 acres of the 140 acre Highway 10 municipal property and providing fifty percent of the road and servicing construction cost. Council heard from Shakir Rehmatullah, from Flato Green Inc, and the vision for 90 acres of land. Council direct staff to develop a draft purchase and sale agreement for the 90 acres of land in Eco Park Phase II.
- The Clerk reported on Lottery Licensing to assist Small Organizations. Council directed staff to send a letter to MPP Bill Walker, on behalf of Mayor Woodbury, to seek his assistance in lobbying the Honourable Doug Downey, to implement an additional level of lottery licensing which would permit small organizations to obtain their own lottery license to hold fundraisers as a method of sustaining their community organization.
- Council has approved a Parking By-law Amendment to prohibit parking on either side of Hagan St West, 100 metres from the Young Street intersection.
- The CAO reported on the Holstein Cemetery Board Use of Surplus Funds from a previously approved funding request to fund the fencing project at the Holstein Cemetery from the Southgate Solar fund. This fencing project came under budget and the Holstein Cemetery Board requested to utilize the remaining funds to further plan and develop the Green Cemetery. Council has approved this request.
- The CAO reported on the Olde Town Hall Project, Council has directed staff to invite Team Town Hall and Wellington Capital Corporation to speak at the November 17, 2021 Council Meeting.
- Council has approved a one-year Customer Service and Support Contract job posting to fill an upcoming temporary vacancy. This position will be posted on the Township of Southgate website, in Township newspapers, and on the Township of Southgate social media pages.
- Deputy Mayor Milne shared highlights from the most recent County Council meeting. More information can be viewed [here](#).
- Councillor Dobreen mentioned that the new after-hours by-law enforcement dedication phone number is now available on the website for members of the public. Council discussed the upcoming Santa Claus Parade events in both Dundalk and Holstein that Council participates in yearly. Deputy Mayor Milne said that the Remembrance Day celebration in Holstein is being held on Sunday, November 7<sup>th</sup> at 2:00pm at the Holstein Cenotaph. The CAO mentioned that the Grey Bruce Public Health Unit has provided two more dates for COVID-19 Vaccination Clinics to be held at the Frank MacIntyre building, on November 22, 2021 from 10:00am-3:00pm and on December 2, 2021 from 12:00pm to 6:00pm.
