

# **Notice of Decision for Minor Variance**

**In the matter** of an application to the Committee of Adjustment of the Township of Southgate under Section 45(2) of the Planning Act of Ontario, R.S.O. 1990, c.P. 13, as amended for lands legally described as Concession 18, N Pt Lot 8, N Pt Lot 9, former Township of Proton, now in the Township of Southgate. Roll 42-07-090-003-11100.

**Decision**: That the Committee of Adjustment, having given consideration to the applicable provisions of Section 45(2) of the Planning Act, the Official Plan of the Township of Southgate, the characteristics of the subject land and its surroundings as addressed in the Planning Report on the subject application dated March 26, 2025, the correspondence received, and information presented at the hearing held on March 26, 2025, and the discussion on the matter, hereby **APPROVE** application **A3-25** to permit a +-3,840 square metre hog barn with 10-month manure storage under the barn, subject to the following conditions:

- 1. That the Minimum Distance Separation requirements be reduced from 392 metres to +-257.2 metres to the house to the south, +-215.6 to the house to the west, +-233.12 metres and 286.7 metres to the houses to the northwest, and +-385.2 metres and 368.1 metres to two homes to the north/northeast; and
- **2. That** all remaining provisions of the Agricultural-1 Zone and other applicable sections of the Zoning By-law are met.

#### Appeal of a Decision

The applicant, the Minister or any other person or public body who has an interest in this matter may within 20 days of the making of the decision appeal to the Tribunal against the decision of the Committee by filing with the secretary-treasurer of the Committee a notice of appeal setting out the objection to the decision and the reasons in support of the objection accompanied by payment to the secretarytreasurer of the fee prescribed by the Ontario Land Tribunal as payable on an appeal from a committee of adjustment to the Tribunal. Any party interested in this application should take legal advice regarding their eligibility to appeal.

The secretary-treasurer of a committee, upon receipt of a notice of appeal filed under subsection (12), shall forthwith forward the notice of appeal and the amount of the fee mentioned in subsection (12) to the Tribunal by registered mail together with all papers and documents filed with the committee of adjustment relating to the matter appealed from and such other documents and papers as may be required by the Tribunal. If within such 20 days no notice of appeal is given, the decision of the committee is final and binding, and the secretary-treasurer shall notify the applicant and shall file a certified copy of the decision with the clerk of the municipality.
