

Dundalk Pool Parents and Attendees Policy

The pool deck and changerooms are for patrons using the pool for swimming.

During lessons, no parents or guardians are permitted to be on deck. Lessons can be viewed by the fence or on the benches. Kids will come out of the changerooms after lessons and can be met by the front doors. Younger children can meet parents in the changerooms for assistance.

During public swim, the only people permitted on deck will be patrons that have paid to swim. No patrons will be allowed to observe on deck. Parents or guardians for a swimmer age 7-10 who is taking the swim test still need to be accompanied by a parent in the pool but can be out of withing arm's reach if they pass the swim test. These parent of children 7-10 must still pay to swim and enter the pool. No child will be allowed in the pool without a parent or guardian to supervise without passing the deep end test.

Anyone is permitted on the deck for rentals as they have booked the pool.
